

WHAT YOU NEED:

Felt - any colours you would like Scrapbooking brads (but can also use thread)

Thread (again any colour)


Ribbon


Needle and pins

Stuffing (I used make up cotton balls because I had no cushion stuffing!)

STEPS:

- 1. Cut out pattern (page 2 of this pdf)
- 2. Pin pattern to your felt and cut out
- you need two bodies, two antlers and one nose
- 3. cut out felt
- 4. Sew the nose to one of your body pieces. (I used a very simple stich)
- 5. Attach brads for eyes and cheeks (or sew little circles to represent these.)
- 6. Sew a mouth.
- 7. Fold Antlers in half and pin to top sides of the body (i.e the head)
- 8. Fold your ribbon and pin to the top
- 9. Pin the second body part to back of your top body piece.
- 10. Start on one side of the bottom body and sew (again a simple sticth) around the pieces taking care to make sure the antlers and ribbon are stiched into the piece as well.
- 11. VIP** Leave a 1cm gap between the start and end of your sewing and stuff the body of the deer with your desired stuffing.
- 12. Sew the gap left in step 11 closed.
- 13. Hang your deer on the tree!





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
